Aim of the Forum: In the context of the intense debate over the legacy of World War II, this public forum will discuss the legal aspects of the 1939 Secret Protocol between the Hitler and Stalin governments that led to the occupation of the Baltic States. What does this mean today: What are the legal and moral consequences for the heir of the USSR, the Russian Federation? How has the international community reacted to the Soviet occupation (legally, diplomatically, et al.) and what initiatives might develop in the future? What actions could be expected from the Baltic governments or civic groups? The forum is envisaged as a contribution to public debate and the core audience will consist of scholars, students, policy makers, the media and diplomatic representatives.
